Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are work-based training programmes that can be used to train both new members of staff and existing employees. This allows them to gain nationally recognised qualifications. Training takes place both in the workplace and at Alliance Learning. Our Subject Specialist Tutors design the curriculum and off-the-job training with you, right from the start to meet your business needs.



ESF Fully Funded Training

In 2019, we were successful in securing funding for the delivery of the 2019-2021 European Social Fund (ESF) programme. Working in partnership with The Growth Company, Skills Support for the Workforce funding can now provide businesses based in Greater Manchester and Lancashire FULLY FUNDED training to develop their business and staff. This includes NVQ's and bespoke training courses (subject to eligibility).



Training Courses

We specialise in sectors such as Health and Safety, First Aid, Plant, Engineering and Professional Development. Foundation Degree in Early Years Childhood Studies

We are currently working in partnership with The University of Bolton to deliver the Foundation Degree in Early Years Childhood Studies Level 4 & 5. This is a work-based course that enables learners to further develop their skills of working with young children and help broaden job opportunities. This course combines lectures, group work and workshop sessions with independent learning.

Reduce recruitment and training costs

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Apprenticeships are funded by the Government, however an employer contribution will be required depending on the age and occupational area of the apprentice.

WHAT ARE MY RESPONSIBILITIES AS AN EMPLOYER?

When hiring an apprentice you must:

- Provide a robust induction to the company and the job role.
- Pay at least the National Minimum Wage for apprentices (currently £3.90 per hour).
- Provide in-house training to complement the Apprenticeship.
- Mentor the apprentice to provide support through the training.
- Provide a safe working environment.
- Allow apprentices to attend 20% off-the-job training.
- Provide a contract of employment for the full duration of the Apprenticeship programme.

APPRENTICESHIP FUNDING REFORMS

In May 2017, the Government changed the way Apprenticeships in England were funded. Some employers are now required to contribute to the Apprenticeship Levy. The levy requires all employers in the UK, with a pay bill over £3 million each year, to invest in apprenticeships. It is paid at a rate of 0.5% of an employer's wage bill, and is paid through Pay As You Earn (PAYE).

Here are things you need to know about the funding reforms:

- If you have a wage bill in excess of £3 million per annum, you will be paying into the levy.
- The levy is charged at a rate of 0.5% of your annual wage bill.
- There is a £15,000 allowance and your contribution will be held in a digital account.
- You have 24 months to spend the money in your digital account.
- If you don't pay into the levy, the Government will pay 95% of the cost of the Apprenticeship, the employer must pay the remaining 5% as a cash contribution.
- If you have unspent levy money, you can transfer up to 25% of this money for other companies to use for Apprenticeship training.
- If you are a small employer with under 50 staff, the Government will pay 100% of the cost of the Apprenticeship for apprentices aged 16-18 years old.
- Employers must allow the apprentice 20% time away from their job for 'off-the-job' training. This is 20% of the apprentice's contracted hours across the whole Apprenticeship.

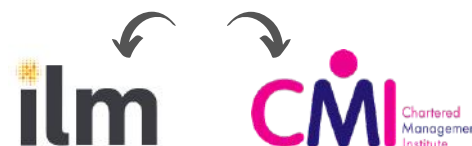

- To develop as a reflective practitioner and setting this in a life-long learning context.
- To develop a critical awareness of current issues within childcare studies and practice.
- To develop proficiency in professional and practical skills associated with their area of expertise.
